This workshop provides relief teachers with SKILLS in planning and preparation for managing the uncertainties of daily relief teaching, STRATEGIES for managing challenging behaviour and building positive relationships with class groups and staff teams, INSIGHT into the various influences that can impact on the teaching experience in each new environment, and TECHNIQUES for self-care as a relief teacher.

The program is provided in two phases: PHASE I—One full day training in February. PHASE II—90 minute regroup, review and reflection in April (4.30pm-6.00pm).

The sessions are facilitated by Rob Mason and Deborah Pyke of D&R School Welfare Support, who between them have over 40 years of experience in the delivery of education and support to young people and their families, and for the last ten years have been responsible for leading support teams in primary and secondary schools in the Northern Metropolitan Region of Melbourne.

This is highly valuable program for all teachers, but is being presented especially for the relief teacher in consideration of the variety of settings and circumstances into which their work takes them from day to day.
