First Aid Management of Anaphylaxis

Training Rebates 2010

Overview

Anaphylaxis Training Rebates have been introduced to encourage Resource Ed teachers to become accredited in First Aid Management of Anaphylaxis 21659VIC.

Teachers - \$35 Rebate Plan

Resource Ed teachers may enroll with an accredited provider of their choice (see recommended providers above). Following completion of the most convenient course, and having met the service qualification below, the teacher may then request by email or phone call to Resource Ed Head Office payment of the **Rebate (up to \$35)**.

10 Placement Service Qualification

Teachers may request the Anaphylaxis Training Rebate immediately upon receipt of evidence of payment, but in consideration of good and fair intent, a qualifying period of 10 teacher placements applies (full or part days) before the Rebate can be authorized for issue. Authorization will be provided for the Anaphylaxis Training Rebate for teachers active with Resource Ed at the time of request, as soon as the 10 day qualification is, or has been met.

Evidence of Provider, Accreditation and Course Fee

The teacher will need to provide Resource Ed with a copy of the Accreditation Certificate and the receipt for payment showing the provider and the fee. The rebates will not exceed the cost of the course.

Renewal of Accreditation

The REdP Anaphylaxis Training Rebate can be claimed on only one occasion, whether as a first-time Accreditation, or as a refresher course.
